



Donating List Cont.

Medical Supplies

1 pt per item listed below donated, no limit on donation

- Gauze (sterile and non sterile) 1 pt per 5 rolls or 1 box
- Bandaids (1 box, at least 50 bandaids)
- Coban (1 roll)
- Ace Wraps (1 roll)
- Splints (any types)
- CPR Masks in hard case
- Medical tape (1 pt per 10 rolls)
- Glucometer
- Glucometer Strips or Lancets
- Disposable Thermometer (1 box)
- Alcohol or Chlorhexidine or Betadine Wipes (1 box)
- Vitamins (1 box can be expired, but must still be sealed)
- Cold Tablets and Liquids (1 pt per bottle or packet, can be expired but must be sealed)
- Antibiotic Cream
- Antifungal Cream
- Muscle Rub Cream
- Saline Bullets or Syringes (1 pt per 10)
- Misc medical items (call Randi Hunewill to verify and get permission for additional points)





Donating List Cont.

Financial Support Options: (Cash or check written to Nevada HOSA)

Chapter Membership Contribution 2/1/2023 is the date the membership # will be drawn

• 50 pts \$5 per member and advisor, all or nothing

e.g. Lincoln HOSA has 15 members and 1 advisor, \$80 = 50 points.

Extra Contribution

Only eligible after Chapter Membership Contribution (above) has been reached.

2/1/2023 is the date the membership # will be drawn

- 1pt 5% over Chapter Membership Contribution
- 2 pts 10% over Chapter Membership Contribution
- 3 pts 15% over Chapter Membership Contribution
- 4 pts 20% over Chapter Membership Contribution
- 5 pts 25% over Chapter Membership Contribution

e.g. Lincoln HOSA has 15 members and 1 advisor. If Lincoln HOSA raises \$84, they would earn 51 points: 50 points for the first \$80 (15 members + 1 advisor = $16 \times $5 = 80) plus 1 additional point from the \$4 above the first \$80 (5% of \$80 = \$4; 5% over Chapter Membership Contribution is 1 point).

^{*}Note for President & VP, candidates must have been a HOSA member for at least 2 years



Election Process

- 1. Fill out the HOSA officer application form
- 2. Complete an interview with the current officers
- 3. Get slated for a position
- 4. Give a speech to the membership
- 5. Member voting... Majority vote wins!

Notes:

- If you're a HOSA officer, you're unable to be an officer or founder of any other WCTA club/ organization
- We're not a hierarchical officer team and put more of an emphasis on the "team" part :)
- ANYONE can apply for office, you do not need to be in the mentorship or have gone to SLC to be an officer
